<p><b><u>Garden Waste</u></b>            Grass and hedge cuttings and leaves ✓            Dead plants and weeds ✓            Small branches (less than 7 cm/3 inches diameter) ✓            Natural bedding (hay, straw, sawdust) from vegetarian pets ✓</p> <p><b><u>Food Waste</u></b>            Fruit and vegetables ✓            Meat and bones ✓            Leftovers, tea bags and egg shells ✓</p>	Plastic bags, flower pots trays ✗ Stones, rubble, soil and turf ✗ Cat litter and animal waste ✗ Poisonous weeds e.g.: Japanese Knotweed and Ragwort ✗ Please do not wrap wet food waste in plastic or corn-starch bags even if degradable ✗
